- **Southlake Families** – 60% of our families have children under the age of 18, making us the most family oriented city in the area. 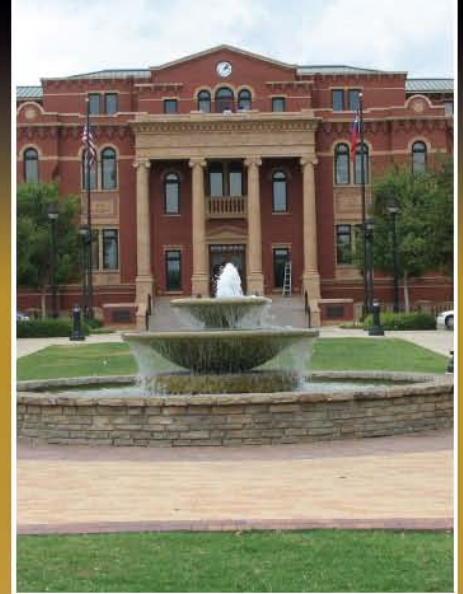
